
Practical Life Ideas

- Create DIY Birdseed Ornaments
 - o I love these ones from Natural Beach Living
- Make and Paint a Birdhouse
 - o This is a great wooden option for preschoolers-kindergarteners.
 - o This is a simpler option made from recycled cartons.
 - Or, you can buy a plain wooden birdhouse at most craft stores and then let your child(ren) paint it!
- Put Clean Water out for Birds
- Pick up Plastic Trash by the Beach/Sea with Gloves
- Bird Watching with Binoculars and Keep a Beginning Bird Journal
- Visit an aviary/bird sanctuary

Sensory Bin Ideas

- Create a bin with fake dirt and fake worms
 - Fake dirt recipe:
 - 1 cup of cocoa powder OR 2 cups of coffee grounds
 - 6-7 cups of flour
 - 1 cup of oil
- Create a bin with mud, sticks, and leaves, and other natural items to make "nests"
- Create a bin with fake dirt or died green rice and bird figures
 - Dyed green rice recipe:
 - 5 cups of rice (or however much you need to fill the bin you are using)
 - A few drops of green food coloring OR a generous squirt of washable green paint
 - 2-3 teaspoons of vinegar
- Create a bin with blue and clear water beads and penguin figures or other water birds
- Create a bin with pieces of grass (or fake grass), fake nest, fake eggs, and plush bird(s)
